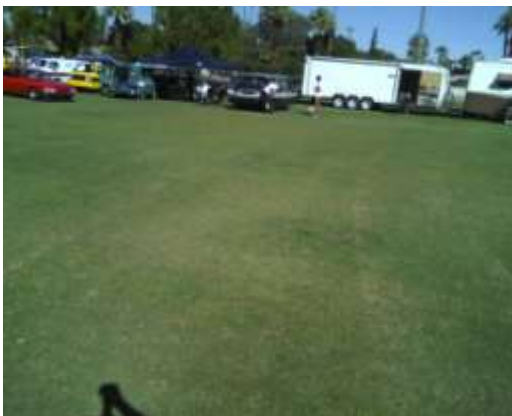
I had a few left over parts for LM airconditioning and was only able to sell one old Sanyo compressor. Even so, I'm sure we all enjoyed the event and will be back next year.
